AGREED ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS
APPEAL TO GRIEVANCE WITH PREJUDICE

This Cause came on to be heard by Motion of the Appellant to Dismiss Appeal to Grievance With Prejudice. The Hearing Officer being fully advised in the premises finds that said Motion is well-taken and is hereby granted based on the following:

1. That the Appellant had filed an appeal of her grievance on a reprimand that she received by the Respondent.
2. That the Respondent has agreed to remove the reprimand concerning the Appellant.
3. That by the Respondent removing the reprimand and all documents of findings concerning the grievance from the Appellant's personnel file, she is removing the grievance and requesting her appeal to be dismissed with prejudice.
4. That the Respondent's personnel file will be restored to the same condition as before the reprimand and grievance were filed, as though neither ever happened.
4. That both the Respondent and Appellant have not admitted to any wrongdoing.
5. That the Appellant is aware that she cannot bring forth this matter in any other action, but any other grievance which are of a separate cause and nature from this matter will


remain unaffected by this Order and shall progress normally per the Rules of MEAB.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Appeal of the
