ORDER

The Appellant, LaShanda Hardy , filed this appeal with the Mississippi Employee Appeals Board on April 25, 2013. A Pre Hearing conference was held in the matter on May 22, 2013. Ms. Hardy was pro se and Mr. David Scott represented the Mississippi Department of Corrections.

During the Pre Hearing conference Hardy testified that she was hired on November 16, 2012, and terminated on April 14, 2013, and that she was a probationary employee. Pursuant to Mississippi Code Ann. §25-9-127 and MEAB Rule III (D) probationary employees may only appeal alleged acts of discrimination.

In her notice of appeal, Ms. Hardy does not allege that she has been discriminated against, nor did she articulate a claim of discrimination against her during the Pre Hearing conference.

Accordingly, since Ms. Hardy has failed to allege a claim of discrimination, this Tribunal lacks jurisdiction of this matter and it is hereby dismissed.
