AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Appealing Party, Tim Leggett and Responding Party, the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, have settled their differences and agreed to entry of this Agreed Order of Dismissal to resolve this action. This Court hereby states and orders as follows:

1. The parties to this action have settled their respective differences and have entered into a Confidential Settlement Agreement;
2. The Appealing Party, Tim Leggett, herein agrees to withdraw his appeal and have it dismissed with prejudice in view the Settlement Agreement and abide by the terms of said Agreement;
3. The Responding Party, the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, agrees to abide by the terms of the settlement and covenants not to retaliate or take any adverse action against the Appealing Party in view of his appeal and the Settlement;
4. Each party shall bear their own costs and attorney fees relative to this action;
5. This court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce this Order of Dismissal as well as the Settlement Agreement; and
6. This Judgment shall be final and this action shall be dismissed with prejudice pursuant to the Settlement Agreement.


