**Mississippi Senate Confirms Appointment**

Jackson, Miss – The Mississippi Senate has confirmed the appointment of Alwyn H. Luckey for a five-year term to the Mississippi State Personnel Board (MSPB) representing the Second Supreme Court District by Governor Phil Bryant. Mr. Luckey was originally appointed to the Board by Governor Bryant in April 2012 to serve an unexpired term through June 30, 2014.
