ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Appellant, Regina Hudson-Kirtz, filed this appeal with the Mississippi Employee Appeals Board on June 19, 2014. On, June 25, 2014, The Respondent, Mississippi Department of Human Services ("MDHS") filed a Motion to Dismiss. That motion was heard, telephonically, on July 30, 2014. Hudson-Kirtz appeared pro se and Sara H. Roberts represented MDHS. This tribunal grants the Motion to Dismiss.

Hudson-Kirtz was employed as A Program Manager at MDHS. On June 21, 2012, Hudson-Kirtz signed an acknowledgement that she was employed in a time limited position "which is excluded from state service status under the Mississippi Code of 1972, Section 25-9-107 (c) (XIV) and is classified by law as non-state service." Pursuant to *Mississippi Code Ann §25-9-149 and MEAB Rule 3. D.* non state service employees may only appeal alleged acts of discrimination.

Hudson-Kirtz failed to allege, in her notice of appeal or at the prehearing conference that MDHS discriminated against her in her employment or termination.

Since Hudson-Kirtz has failed to allege a claim of discrimination this tribunal lacks jurisdiction of this matter and it is hereby dismissed.
