ORDER

Appellant, Mark Pitner, filed a Request for Review by the Mississippi Employee Appeals Board ("MEAB") Full Board in the instant matter. The Request having been filed untimely is denied.

The record shows that the Hearing Officer's Order in this matter was filed on May 10, 2015. Pitner filed his Request for Review by the MEAB Full Board on June 4, 2015.

Rule XXV. of the Administrative Rules of the Employee Appeals Board states as follows:

- A. Any party aggrieved by the final written decision and order of a presiding hearing officer entered on the hearing of an appeal may file a written Request for Review by the full EAB.
- B. The request must be filed within fifteen days after the date the final order is filed. . .

The request for Review by the Full Board was required to be filed no later than May 26, 2015. Pitner filed his Request on June 4, 2015. Accordingly, the MEAB denies Pitner's Request for Review by the MEAB Full Board because Pitner did not timely file his request.

For the foregoing reasons this Request for Review is denied.
