ORDER

Presently before the Mississippi Employee Appeals Board is the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss filed on July 22, 2016. On August 5, 2016, this tribunal heard the argument of the parties and after considering the same, finds the motion well taken.

On or about May 20, 2016, the Appellant Barbara Gilbert filed an appeal with the MEAB related to a denial of a request to be transferred due to difficulties with her co-workers. On or about July 19, 2016, the Appellant submitted her resignation to the Respondent, her employer, effective July 29, 2016. The sole "relief sought" in this appeal was "I prefer to be transferred to another building with the same pay and with the same hours. Hours 7am-3pm." As the Appellant is no longer employed with Respondent, the appeal is moot and should be dismissed. During the hearing, the Respondent informed the Appellant that she is eligible for rehire with a favorable rehire status.

Accordingly, Barbara Gilbert's appeal to tribunal is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
