SUBJECT: LIFTING OF SUSPENSION OF HIRING, PROMOTIONS AND OTHER  
PERSONNEL ACTIONS

On November 28, 1990, in accordance with Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated, Section 25-9-116 and recommendation by the Department of Finance and Administration, the State Personnel Board, acting through the State Personnel Director, authorized and directed a suspension for all hirings, promotions, reclassifications, reallocations and pay grade realignments effective December 3, 1990, until such time as the Department of Finance and Administration should recommend that such action was no longer required.

The Department of Finance and Administration has notified the State Personnel Board through correspondence on February 10, 1992, (see attached) that the need for the suspension of hiring, promotions and other personnel actions has ended. Therefore, as a result of notification from the Department of Finance and Administration, the suspension is hereby lifted, effective immediately. Personnel requests should be submitted to the State Personnel Board in accordance with standard policies and procedures outlined in the Mississippi State Personnel Board Policy Manual and the Mississippi State Personnel Board Forms and Procedures Manual.
