AGREED ORDER

The Appellant, Floyd Spotts, and the Mississippi Department of Corrections (MDOC), by and through their attorneys, acknowledge that they have come to an agreement of all matters relative to this appeal and IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Appellant agrees to dismiss this Appeal and in return MDOC agrees to reinstate Appellant to a position of Correctional Officer IV (a demotion from Correctional Supervisor) with no back pay due to the Appellant. The reinstatement is effective October 10, 2012. The period of time between June 12, 2012 and October 9, 2012 shall be considered a suspension from work without pay. The Appellant shall be entitled to all other benefits of employment.

This settlement concludes all matters relative to this appeal and this cause is dismissed with prejudice. The settlement shall not be construed as an admission of liability by either party.
