ORDER


The Appellant, Stacey N. Johnson, filed this appeal with the Mississippi Employee Appeals Board on July 30, 2013. A hearing was held in the matter on September 10, 2013. Johnson appeared pro se and Mr. David Scott represented the Mississippi Department of Corrections.

During the hearing, Johnson testified that she was hired on September 4, 2012, and was terminated on July 6, 2013, and that she was a probationary employee. Pursuant to Mississippi Code Ann. §25-9-127 and MEAB Rule III (D) probationary employees may only appeal alleged acts of discrimination. During the hearing Johnson acknowledged that she had not been terminated for any discriminatory reasons recognized by the State of Mississippi or the Mississippi State Personnel Board.

Accordingly, since Johnson has failed to prove a claim of discrimination, this matter is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
